We know that Treehouse programs are life-changing for foster kids. We see the results every day. But there are more kids out there who need our services, kids living with the devastating effects of abuse and neglect. That's why the refrain “serve more kids and serve them better” underlies every decision we make.

We're pleased to report that in 2007 Treehouse did serve more kids – 52 percent more than last year (4,409 kids, compared to 2,898 in 2006). Much of that growth was due to the statewide expansion of our Educational Advocacy program, but for nearly every Treehouse program 2007 was a year of impressive growth. We expanded our reach in King County and retooled our Tutoring program to give kids more hours of intensive one-on-one and small-group instruction. We encouraged kids to shop in the Wearhouse more often, sent more kids to camp and granted more little wishes than ever.

Fortunately for Treehouse, the generous support of donors and partners has kept pace with the growth in our programs. In 2007, a number of community partnerships produced outstanding results:

- Seattle University received a five-year, \$1 million grant from the Schultz Family Foundation for the Treehouse-SU Partnership, a program that engages SU students as Treehouse tutors and provides training resources for Treehouse staff. In addition, the SU Fostering Scholars program awarded four new scholarships in its second year – eleven Coaching-to-College students have now received full scholarships through this remarkable program.
- The Seattle Seahawks once again selected Treehouse as a partner in its Spirit of 12 Partners Program. The program raises money for Treehouse while raising our profile in the community.
- The Casey Family Programs City Year team that staffed the Treehouse Learning Center won the program's national T-Mobile Outstanding Afterschool Program Award for its work at Treehouse.

As we head into 2008, our 20th anniversary year, everyone at Treehouse is proud of how far we've come. We're most proud of the kids who pass through our programs and come out with a broader view of the world, a better understanding of themselves, or more confidence in school and in life. Those kids inspire us to renew our commitment to serve more kids and serve them better. And that's just what we'll do.

Our Achievements 2007

Coaching-to-College

Coaching-to-College (CTC) expanded into middle school, engaging 143 students in group workshops and field trips to help them start dreaming of a future that includes college and careers. High school CTC served an additional 134 students, offering information about colleges, testing and application workshops, and matches with volunteer coach-mentors for one-on-one help navigating the road to higher education. CTC also awarded nearly \$44,000 in scholarships to more than 50 college-bound students.

Educational Advocacy

In its first full year operating statewide, Treehouse Educational Advocacy saw monumental growth, nearly tripling the number of students served by the program (2,604, compared to 970 the previous year). Advocates spent more than 10,600 hours working with schools, social workers, caregivers and students to support foster kids' educational rights and improve their chances of academic success. In nearly three quarters of advocates' cases, students achieved their desired outcomes or were well on their way to doing so at year's end.



Little Wishes

Little Wishes fulfilled 3,738 wishes, giving more than 1,100 foster kids the opportunity to participate in extracurricular and school activities.

Little Wishes scholarships helped pay for a wide range of wishes, including 1,148 for sports, 992 for school activities and 693 for music and arts.

Treehouse sent 554 kids to the day or overnight camp of their choice during the summer of 2007. Of these, 85 attended Camp Sealath, thanks to an ongoing partnership with Camp Fire USA Puget Sound Council that lets Treehouse send youth to the camp at cost.

Tutoring

Seven state-certified teachers, working with closely supervised community volunteers, provided more than 6,800 hours of academic assistance and advocacy to 205 students in six Seattle public schools during the school day. Their students achieved an average gain of more than a full grade level. After school and during school breaks, 180 students received more than 6,800 hours of instruction in the Treehouse Learning Center.



Summer Camp

Wearhouse

The Wearhouse served more than 2,500 foster kids in 2007, up nearly 20 percent from the previous year. And kids shopped more often, going on nearly 5,000 shopping trips, 25 percent more than last year. During the year the Wearhouse distributed more than \$1 million worth of donated merchandise.
